



CERTIFICATION OF SUPERVISED DRIVING

Please print and sign by hand prior to visiting an Agency

An applicant for a probationary driver license who has a special learner's permit, or who is under the age of 21 and has an examination permit, must have driven a minimum of 50 hours with supervision, including 10 hours during darkness.

An applicant's driving privileges shall be suspended for six months for submission of a fraudulent certification of a parent, guardian or supervising driver.

CERTIFICATION

I certify that I am the parent/guardian of the applicant, or that I am at least 21 years of age and hold a valid New Jersey driver's license, and that I accompanied and supervised the applicant during practice driving hours. I certify that the applicant has completed a minimum of 50 hours of supervised driving, including 10 hours during darkness. I certify that any supervised driving hours were completed under the immediate supervision of a person at least 21 years of age who holds a valid New Jersey license to operate the type of vehicle that was used.
